How to Use These Files – Words Only for Print or Projection

These documents were not designed to be used as-is but are formatted for easy copying and pasting into your document or projection system. Here's how:

- **1. You will need a PDF reader.** Except for this text file, all resource files are saved in Adobe's Portable Document Format (PDF). Open them using the free Adobe Acrobat Reader available from adobe.com/reader or a similar reader of your choice.
- **2. You will need to know the song number.** Each song has been saved as an individual file numbered the same as the print edition. Don't have a printed copy? Use the included Index of First Lines and Common Titles to find the song number.
- **3.** Using the song number as a reference, find it in the appropriate section folder. For example, if you need song #680, "O God, We Kneel Before Your Throne" you would open the folder 2.2.2 Forgiveness and Grace. Inside this folder is a file named "680-O-God-We-Kneel-Before-Your-Throne."
- 3. Open the PDF file.
- **4. Copy and paste the text.** Copy the text you would like to use from the PDF and paste into Microsoft Word or other program.
- **5. Format the copied text** to fit your preferred style for font and size.
- **6. Don't forget to include the copyright information.** If the text is not in the public domain, include your license number or indicate in some way that you have received permission to print or project the text. For help with copyrights go to www.liftupyourheartshymnal.org
